

**IRREVOCABLE REJECTION OF CITY COUNCIL  
RETIREE HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS**


This City Council has, by its prior adoption of its Resolution 08-57, dated November 17, 2008 expressly empowered each City Councilmember to elect to receive health and welfare benefits, as specified in Resolution 08-57, or to forego such taxpayer funded benefits.

The City Council did not specify any form or protocol by which a City Councilmember could reject, with certainty, the available Retiree Health Insurance Benefits.

The Councilmember who has affixed his or her signature below hereby represents and affirms the following declarations:

- (i) That the City Councilmember has freely, voluntarily and without compulsion executed this IRREVOCABLE REJECTION OF RETIREE HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS form;
- (ii) That the City Councilmember intends to immediately and irrevocably terminate his or her right to receive City of Mission Viejo provided Retiree Health Insurance Benefits, as described in Resolution 08-57;
- (iii) That the Councilmember intends and agrees that this form, once completed, signed and delivered to the City Manager will be treated as a public record, not subject to any exemption that may otherwise be available pursuant to the California Public Records Act (California Government Code Section 6250 *et seq.*) and the common law arising thereunder; and
- (iv) That the City offices shall, without further action by the Councilmember who has executed this IRREVOCABLE REJECTION OF CITY COUNCIL RETIREE HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS.

I, Lance R. MacLean, have executed this document titled IRREVOCABLE REJECTION OF CITY COUNCIL RETIREE HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December with the express request that such benefits no longer accrue to me, or anyone claiming by, through or under me, as of 8:00 am on December 2, 2009.
